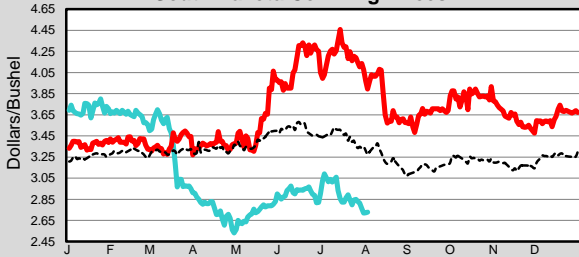

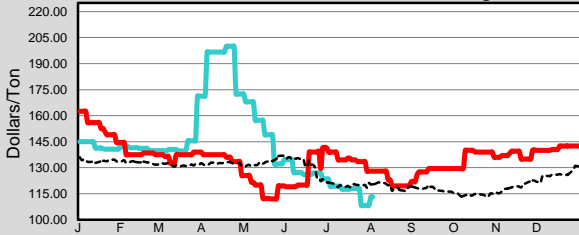

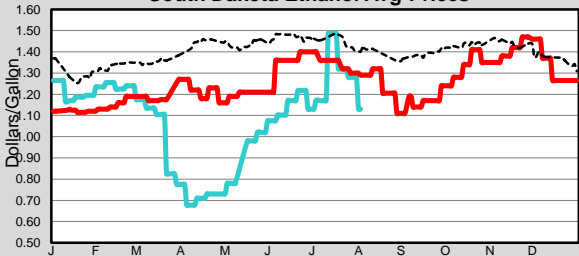
South Dakota Corn Avg Prices

BIO-ENERGY REPORT NOTES

Yellow corn : US #2 daily spot bids at ethanol plants reported as \$/per bushel.

Ethanol: Weekly spot bids FOB the ethanol plant reported as \$/gallon.

Distiller grains: Weekly spot bids FOB the ethanol plant reported as \$/per ton. Protein content 28-30% for most distiller grains on a dry matter basis.

Distiller corn oil: Weekly Spot bids FOB the ethanol plant reported as ¢/lb. Distiller corn oil is intended for animal feed or biofuel and is not Generally Regarded As Safe (GRAS) for human consumption. It may also be referred to as inedible crude corn oil or crude corn oil.

B100: Weekly spot bids FOB the plant reported as \$/gallon. RIN value not included in price

Delivered Distillers: Weekly spot bids FOB the export point reported in \$/ton, except for Texas Border expressed in \$/metric ton.
