


Grain and Feedstuffs Market Trend

Compared to two weeks ago: Trade activity and demand moderate for organic feed grade corn and soybeans. Trade inactive on organic feed grade wheat.

Demand light. Trade activity light on organic soybean oil with demand good. Imported organic soybean meal prices are negatively impacting domestic crushing. Trade inactive on all other organic grains. Feed mills are taking in new crop organic corn and soybeans. Cash market remains unchanged from pre-harvest bids. Bid prices FOB for feed grade organic corn range from 7.60 to 9.00 with organic feed soybeans 19.00. The next available report will be Wednesday, November 20, 2019.

Current Midwest Drought Summary (October 29, 2019)

On this week's map, one-category improvements were made in areas of Severe Drought (D2) and Moderate Drought (D1) in Indiana and Kentucky in response to precipitation accumulations ranging from 1-to-3 inches. According to the USGS, streamflows are running at normal to well above normal levels across nearly the entire region. According to the USDA for the week ending October 27th, the percent of subsoil by state rated short to very short was as follows: Minnesota 1%, lowa 2%, Missouri 3%, Wisconsin 0%, Illinois 12%, Michigan 4%, Indiana 39%, Ohio 43%, and Kentucky 49%. For the week, average temperatures were mainly near normal to slightly above normal across much of Indiana, Kentucky, and Ohio, while further west in the region temperatures were 4-to-8 degrees below normal.
