Compared to last sale(7-15-20): The last reported sale was nearly a month ago. Feeder steers sold 5.00-10.00 higher than the last reported feeder special in July. Feeder heifers sold sharply higher than the July sale with most sale 15.00-20.00 higher. Quality this week was mostly average to attractive. Demand was moderate to good for all yearling type cattle. Offerings were mostly moderate. A large crowd of buyers were on hand actively bidding on cattle. Feeder cattle were in mostly light flesh as many were coming out of dry country or where grasshoppers destroyed much of the forage. Cattle selling in load lots sold on mostly good demand while cattle offered in packages sold on mostly moderate demand. Market activity today was mostly moderate to active. Weigh up cows sold on mostly light demand. Offerings were light. Packers showed light demand for slaughter cows this sale allowing feeding buyers to purchase the majority of the offering. Slaughter and feeding cows and bulls will not be trended today due to the length of time between reported sales. Slaughter bulls sold on mostly light to moderate demand. Feeding bull buyers entered the market this sale and purchased many thinner and lower dressing bulls this sale. Feeding cows sold on mostly moderate demand. Buyers were able to buy almost all of the high quality cows away from packers. Quality this sale was average to attractive. Weigh up conditions were average to below average. Supply included: 83% Feeder Cattle (53% Steers, 44% Heifers, 3% Bulls); 6% Slaughter Cattle (36% Cows, 64% Bulls); 11% Replacement Cattle (100% Stock Cows). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 97%.
