Compared to last week: Yearling steers were too lightly tested to develop any market trend. Yearling heifers were too lightly tested to develop an accurate market trend, however steady to higher undertones were noticed. Unweaned calves were too lightly tested to develop any market trend. Demand for yearlings and calves was moderate. Quality this week was plain to average on yearlings and average to attractive on calves. Yearling quality overall was lower than last week. Yearlings were offered in mostly mostly small packages with no load lots seen this week. All feeders on offer were in light flesh. Limited yearlings made it difficult for buyers to put together loads which slightly hindered demand. Yearling weigh up conditions were mostly average to below average this week. Market activity was mostly slow to moderate. Weigh up cows sold on mostly light to moderate demand and offerings. Packer buyers showed light demand for all cows on offer. Slaughter cows sold mostly 1.00 to 3.00 lower on lean and boning cows. Breaking cows sold with steady undertones in a narrow comparison. Feeding cows sold mostly 1.00-4.00 lower. Slaughter bulls sold mostly 2.00 lower. Cow quality this week was mostly average. Many cows were coming out of dry country and were in thin flesh. Young age 2-3 year old cows suitable to re-breed sold mostly 5.00-8.00 higher. Quality this week was average to attractive. More buyers showed interest in purchasing this class of cow compared to the last few weeks. Demand was moderate to good as a result. Supply included: 38% Feeder Cattle (41% Steers, 49% Heifers, 9% Bulls); 36% Slaughter Cattle (86% Cows, 14% Bulls); 26% Replacement Cattle (89% Stock Cows, 9% Bred Cows, 3% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 66%.
