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## SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

### DELIVERIES

Preliminary March 1981 sugar distribution for continental consumption totaled 872,424 short tons, raw value, up 1 percent from March 1980. January-March 1981 distribution for continental consumption was down 10 percent from the first quarter of 1980. Sugar delivered for export in the first two months of 1981 continued at a rate in excess of 50,000 tons per month--the same level as in 1980.

### INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on March 28, 1981 totaled 3.1 million short tons, raw value, down over 10 percent from a month earlier and down 8 percent from a year ago.

### DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

January-February sugar production for the mainland United States totaled 1.2 million short tons, raw value, up 9 percent from the same period in 1980. Hawaiian sugar production for the first 13 weeks of 1981 was 118,277 short tons, up 22 percent from the five year average.

### IMPORTS

Imported raw sugar receipts by U.S. Cane refiners for January-February 1981 were 634,193 short tons, raw value, down 4 percent from the first two months of 1980. Argentina and Brazil each shipped over 100,000 tons to the U.S. during the period. Refined imports totaled less than 1,000 tons for the first two months of 1981.

### SUGAR PRICES

Raw sugar prices declined 2 cents per pound in March 1981, with world prices averaging under 22 cents per pound. Wholesale refined sugar prices also declined, ranging from 5 percent for Northeast and Southeast cane to 10 percent for Chicago-west beet.
