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## SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

### DELIVERIES

Sugar distribution for Continental consumption for the first quarter of 1985 totaled 1.9 million short tons, raw value, down 6 percent from a year ago. Sugar exports for January - March were 117,793 tons.

### INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on March 31, 1985, totaled 3.3 million short tons, raw value, up 17 percent from March 31, 1984.

### DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Sugar production for the Mainland United States for January - March 1985 totaled 1.5 million short tons, raw value, up 6 percent from the same period a year ago.

Hawaiian sugar production for January - March 1985 totaled 84,156 tons, down 30 percent from a year ago.

### IMPORTS

Receipts of raw imported sugar by U.S. cane refiners for January - March 1985 totaled 864,734 short tons, raw value, down 16 percent from the same period a year ago. Brazil with 145,229 tons and Argentina with 107,725 tons accounted for the largest and second largest tonnages.
