SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS DELIVERIES

Sugar distribution for Continental consumption for January-September 1986 totaled 5.8 million short tons, raw value, down 3 percent from a year ago. Sugar exports for January-September totaled 389,704 tons.

INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on September 30, 1986, totaled 1.3 million short tons, raw value, 14 percent below a year ago.

DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Production for the Mainland United States for January-September 1986 totaled 2.2 million short tons, raw value, up 3 percent from the same period a year ago.

Hawaiian sugar production as of August 31, 1986 totaled 692,158 tons.

IMPORTS

Receipts of raw imported sugar by U.S. cane refiners totaled 1.7 million short tons, raw value, down 19 percent from a year ago. The Dominican Republic with 292,196 tons and the Philippines with 182,570 tons accounted for the largest and second largest tonnages.
