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SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS DELIVERIES

Sugar distribution for Continental consumption for first quarter of 1990 totaled 2.0 million short tons, raw value, 3 percent above a year ago. Sugar exports for the first quarter of 1990 totaled 121,232 short tons, raw value.

INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U. S. primary distributors on March 31, 1990, totaled 3.1 million short tons, raw value, down 9 percent from a year ago.

DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Sugar production for the Mainland United States for January 1 through March 31, 1990 totaled 1.6 million tons, raw value, down 9 percent from last year.

Hawaiian sugar production totaled 62,734 tons through March 31, 1990.

IMPORTS

Receipts of raw imported sugar by U. S. cane refiners for first quarter of 1990 totaled .6 million short tons, raw value, 30 percent above last year. Brazil with 207,855 tons and Guatemala with 69,850 tons accounted for the largest and second largest tonnages.
