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SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

DELIVERIES

Preliminary August 1981 sugar distribution for Continental consumption totaled 831,920 short tons, raw value, down 8 percent from August 1980. Total January-July 1981 sugar deliveries for export totaled more than 3/4 million tons, raw value.

INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on August 29, 1981 totaled 1.5 million short tons, raw value, down 19 percent from a year earlier and down 22 percent from a month earlier.

DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Sugar production for the Mainland United States during the first seven months of 1981 totaled 2.0 million short tons, raw value, up 9 percent from January-July 1980.

Hawaiian sugar production for the first 34 weeks of 1981 totaled 714,969 short tons, raw value, up 8 percent from the five year average.

IMPORTS

During July 1981, U.S. cane refiners received imports of 447,748 short tons, raw value of sugar, bringing the total for the first seven months to 2,648,042 tons. Shipments from the Dominican Republic, the leading shipper thus far in 1981 passed the one-half million ton mark in July. Refined imports continued small, totaling 2,146 tons during January-July 1981.

SUGAR PRICES

The number 11 contract world raw sugar price fell dramatically in August 1981 from over 16 cents per pound at the beginning of the month to 12.38 cents per pound at month's end, averaging 14.76 cents per pound for the month.

Refined wholesale list sugar prices in the U.S. declined in August for all regions and types, ranging from less than 1 percent for Chicago West cane to over 6 percent for Pacific Coast beet sugar.
