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United States
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SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

DELIVERIES

Sugar distribution for Continental consumption for January-September of 1990 totaled 6.3 million short tons, raw value, 3 percent above a year ago. Sugar exports for January-September 1990 totaled 436,250 short tons, raw value, up 7 percent from this time last year.

INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U. S. primary distributors on September 30, 1990 totaled 1.1 million short tons, raw value, up 4 percent from this time last year.

DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Sugar production for the Mainland United States for January 1 through September 30, 1990 totaled 0.7 million tons, raw value, down 20 percent from last year.

Hawaiian sugar production totaled 657,236 tons through September 30, 1990.

IMPORTS

Receipts of raw imported sugar by U. S. cane refiners for January-September 1990 totaled 2.2 million short tons, raw value, 44 percent above this period last year. Dominican Republic with 301,746 and Colombia with 293,429 tons accounted for the largest and second largest tonnages.
