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SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

DELIVERIES

Preliminary November 1981 sugar distribution for Continental consumption totaled 739,118 short tons, raw value, up 4 percent from November 1980. Sugar exports slacked off somewhat in October from the 100,000 tons a month pace set during January-September 1981. Total exports for January-October 1981, however, were still well over 1/2 million tons ahead of the corresponding period in 1980, the previous record.

INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on November 28, 1981 totaled 2.1 million short tons, raw value, up 34 percent from a month earlier, but down 9 percent from a year earlier.

Refiners' raw inventories were slightly higher than at the end of November 1980, but inventories of all other groups were less than a year ago.

DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Sugar production for the Mainland United States during January-October 1981 totaled 2.9 million short tons, raw value, up 8 percent from production during the first 10 months of 1980.

Hawaiian sugar production for the first 48 weeks of 1981 totaled 1,021,859 tons, up 2 percent from the five-year average.

IMPORTS

During October 1981, U.S. cane refiners imported 355,921 short tons of sugar, raw value, bringing the total for the first 10 months to 4,076,616 tons, up 11 percent from January-October 1980.

During the first 10 months of 1981, Argentina and Australia together shipped 588,421 tons more raw sugar to the U.S. than they did in the same period of 1980. However, the large increases from these two countries were partially offset by smaller imports from many other foreign countries. Imports of raw sugar from all foreign countries combined during this 10 month period totaled 409,131 tons more than in the same period of 1980.
