SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

DELIVERIES

Preliminary February 1982 sugar deliveries for Continental consumption totaled 637,110 short tons, raw value, down 6 percent from February 1981. January-February 1982 distribution for Continental consumption decreased 7 percent from the first two months of 1981. Compared to a year earlier, sugar distribution for export fell sharply in January 1982, down 82 percent.

INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on February 27, 1982 totaled 3.6 million short tons, raw value, down 3 percent from a month earlier, but up 5 percent from a year ago.

DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Sugar production for the Mainland United States during January 1982 totaled 744,778 short tons, raw value, down 2 percent from January 1981. Hawaiian production for the first 8 weeks of 1982 was 42,156 short tons, raw value, up 45 percent from the five year average.

IMPORTS

Receipts of raw imported sugar reported by U.S. cane refiners for January 1982 totaled 291,391 short tons, raw value, down 7 percent from January 1981. The four leading shippers were Argentina, Australia, Brazil and Swaziland. These four countries accounted for nearly 60 percent of the imported receipts.

Major modifications in the program of the Statistical Reporting Service are required to stay within fiscal 1982 funding levels. As a result, "Weekly Sugar Distribution" and "Sugar Market Statistics" and a large number of other reports are being discontinued or altered. The last weekly sugar report was issued on March 11 and this is the last issue of "Sugar Market Statistics".
