## Consumption Up 2 Percent, Stocks Up 15 Percent

Sugar distribution for Continental consumption for the first six months of 1991 totaled 4.10 million short tons, raw value, 2 percent above a year ago. Sugar exports for the January 1-June 30 1991 period totaled 295,542 short tons, raw value, up 12 percent from this time last year.

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on June 30, 1991 totaled 2.43 million short tons, raw value, up 15 percent from a year ago.

Domestic production for the Mainland United States for first half of 1991 totaled 2.54 million tons, raw value, up 34 percent from last year.

Hawaiian sugar production totaled 296,721 tons through June 29, 1991.

Imports of raw sugar by U.S. cane refiners for the first six months of 1991 totaled 1.39 million short tons, raw value, up 3 percent from last year. Guatemala with 301,912 and Dominican Republic with 199,683 tons accounted for the largest and second largest tonnages.
