## SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

### DELIVERIES

Sugar distribution for Continental consumption for the first quarter of 1983 totaled 2,068,672 short tons, raw value, down less than 1 percent from the first quarter of 1982.

Revised sugar distribution for Continental consumption for calendar year 1982 totaled 9,115,023 short tons, raw value, down 6 percent from 1981. Revised sugar distribution for Continental consumption for January-September 1982 totaled 6,872,471 short tons, raw value, down 8 percent from 1981.

### INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on March 31, 1983 totaled 3 million short tons, raw value, down 16 percent from a year earlier. Revised December 31, 1982 sugar stocks totaled 2.9 million short tons, raw value, down 13 percent from a year earlier. Revised September 30, 1982 sugar stocks totaled 1.5 million short tons, raw value, up 8 percent from a year earlier.

### DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Sugar production for the mainland United States for the first quarter of 1983 totaled 1.4 million short tons, raw value, up 3 percent from 1982.

Revised sugar production for the mainland United States for calendar year 1982 totaled 5 million short tons, raw value, down 4 percent from 1981.

Revised sugar production for the mainland United States for January-September 1982 totaled 2.2 million short tons, raw value, down 3 percent from 1981. Hawaiian sugar production for the first quarter of 1983 totaled 120,332 tons, raw value, up 66 percent from the first quarter of 1982.

### IMPORTS

Receipts of raw imported sugar by U.S. cane refiners in the first quarter of 1983 totaled 643,101 short tons, raw value, down 27 percent from 1982. The leading shipper, the Dominican Republic, shipped just over 125,000 tons. Brazil was second with just over 70,000 tons.
