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Milk Cows and Production Final Estimates 2003-2007

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Summary

Milk: Final Estimates by State, 2003-2007, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Agricultural Statistics Board, National Agricultural Statistics Service, Statistical Bulletin No. 1022.

Introduction: This bulletin presents final estimates, including revisions made by the Agricultural Statistics Board (ASB), for the production years 2003 through 2007. Number of milk cows, production per cow, and total production were published during calendar years 2003-2007 in periodic ASB reports. The number of livestock operations and inventory by size groups will be published in Livestock Operations - Final Estimates 2003-2007, Statistical Bulletin No. 1021. Data included in this publication provide a historic record and a benchmark for current estimates. Disposition and Income data will be published in the Milk Disposition and Income - Final Estimates 2003-2007 Statistical Bulletin No. 1027.

Procedures: Revisions were made after a thorough review of the original survey data and all additional data now available, including the 2007 Census of Agriculture. Other data series considered included Federal Milk Market Orders, receipts of milk by plants and dealers, and any other available administrative information. The 2003-2007 estimates shown herein are considered final and will not be revised again.

At the National level, revisions to estimates of milk production and annual number of milk cows were less than one percent.

Agricultural Census Publications: The U. S. Department of Agriculture's National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) released several products from the 2007 Census of Agriculture on February 4, 2009. The Census is the leading source of statistics about the Nation's agricultural production and the only source of consistent, comparable data at the county, State, and national levels. The Census includes all places from which \$1,000 or more of agricultural products, including government payments, were produced and sold, or normally would have been sold, during the census year. Census publications also include demographic items such as sex of operator, residence on or off the farm, days worked off farm, years present on farm, age group categories, race, and number of persons living in each household.

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
