ROUGH RICE STOCKS: Storage of rough rice in all positions January 1, 1978 totaled 86.1 million hundredweight (3.9 million metric tons) compared with last year's record high 100.1 million cwt. (about 4 million MT). These estimates include stocks on farms, in mills and warehouses, ports and in transit for the six major rice producing States.

Of the total rice stocks, 50.7 million cwt. (2.3 million MT) was long grain varieties, 27.4 million cwt. (1.2 million MT) was medium grain and 8.0 million cwt. (365 thousand MT) was short grain. Last January there were 55.0 million cwt. (2.5 million MT) long grain, 36.5 million cwt. (1.7 million MT) medium grain and 8.6 million cwt. (391 thousand MT) short grain.

MILLED RICE STOCKS: Stocks of milled rice in all positions on January 1 totaled 6.4 million hundredweight (291 thousand MT), up sharply from last year's 4.3 million cwt. (197 thousand MT). The milled rice stocks consisted of 5.5 million cwt. (248 thousand MT) whole kernel rice and 943 thousand cwt. (43 thousand MT) second heads and broken kernels.
