Poultry - Production and Value: Final Estimates by States and United States, 1994-97, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Agriculture Statistics Board, National Agricultural Statistics Service, Statistics Bulletin No. 958.

Procedures: Revisions were made after a through review of the original survey data and all additional data now available, including the 1997 Census of Agriculture. The 1994-97 estimates shown herein are considered final and will not be revised again.

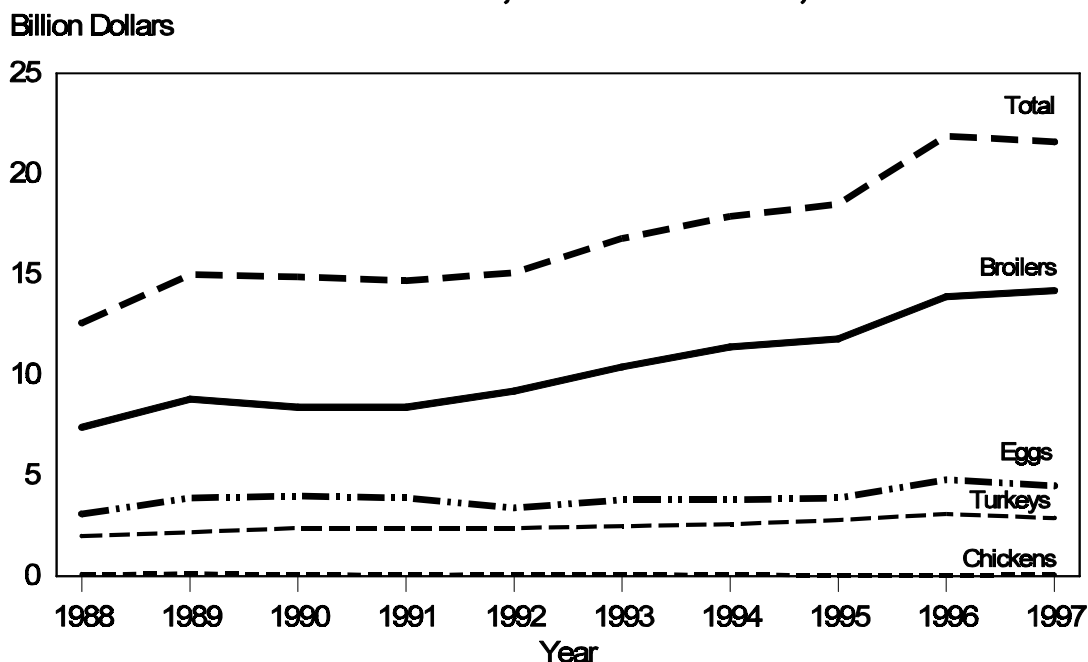

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Value of Production: Broilers, Eggs, Turkeys, Chickens and Total, United States, 1988-1997



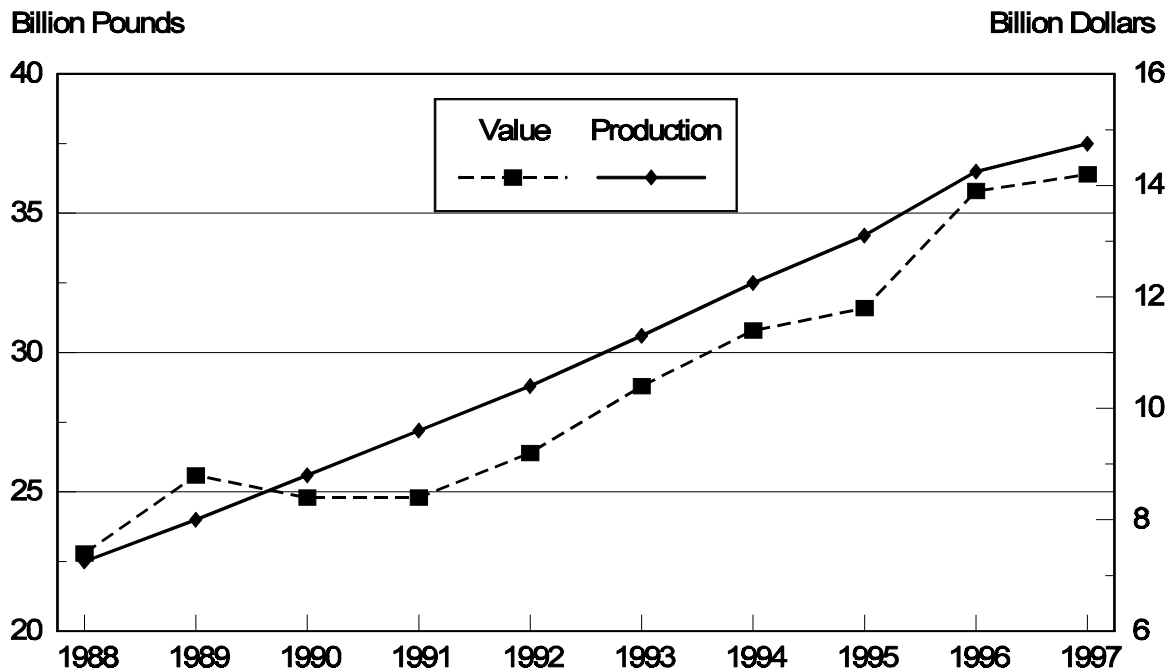

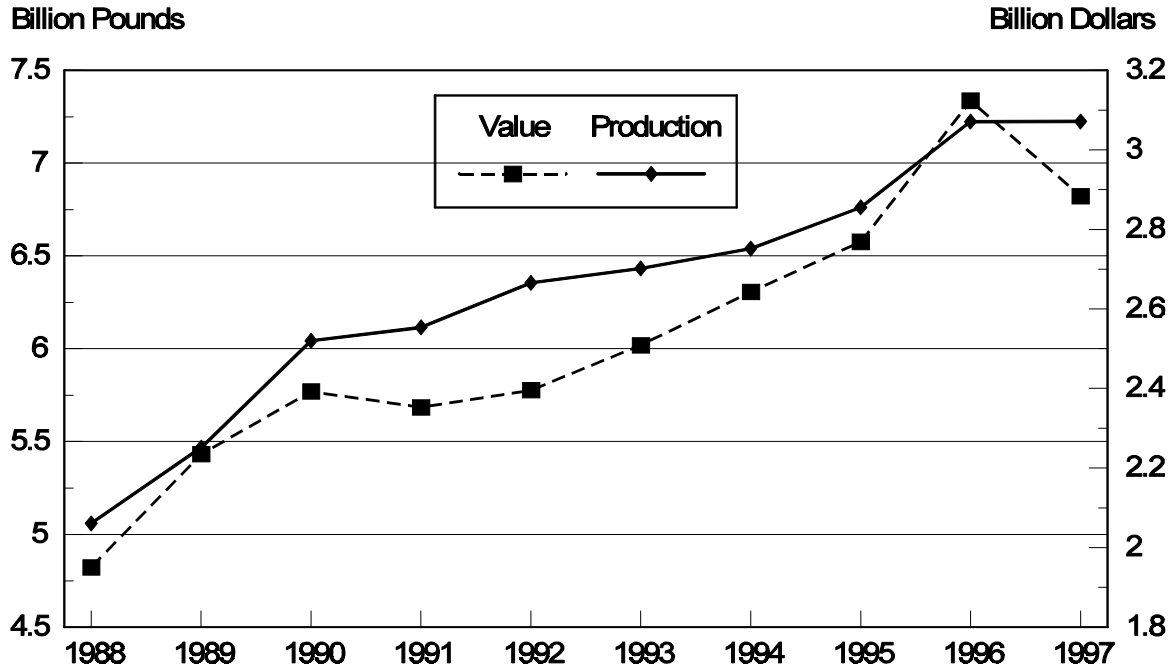

Turkey Production and Value of Production, United States, 1988-97



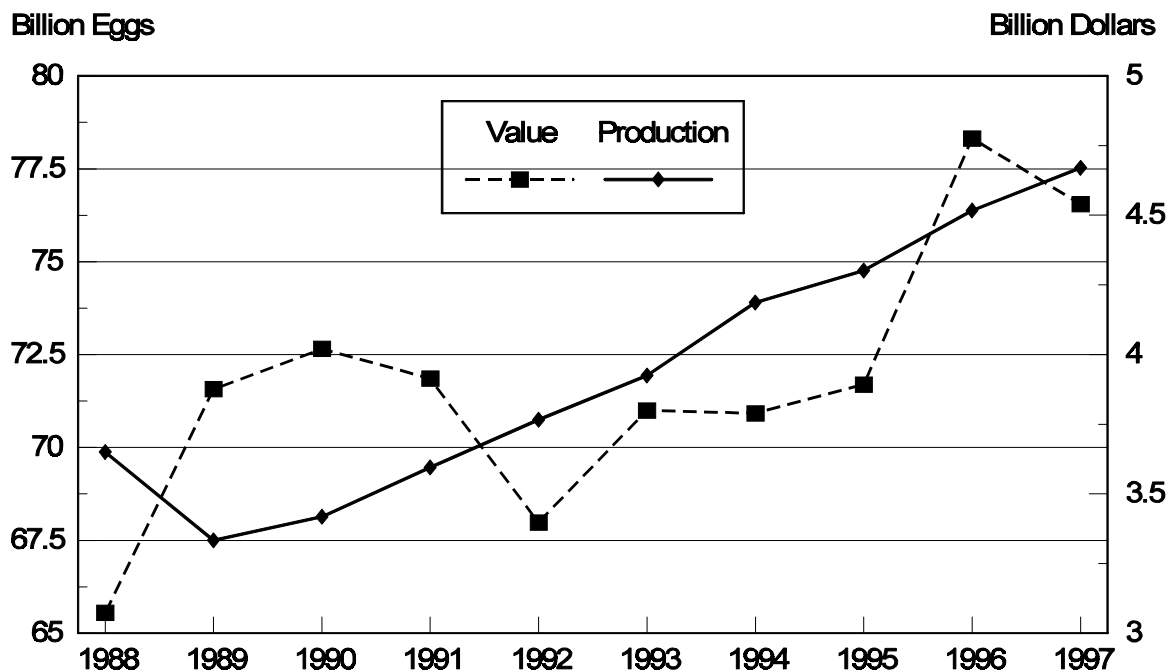

All Egg Production and Value of Production, United States, 1988-97



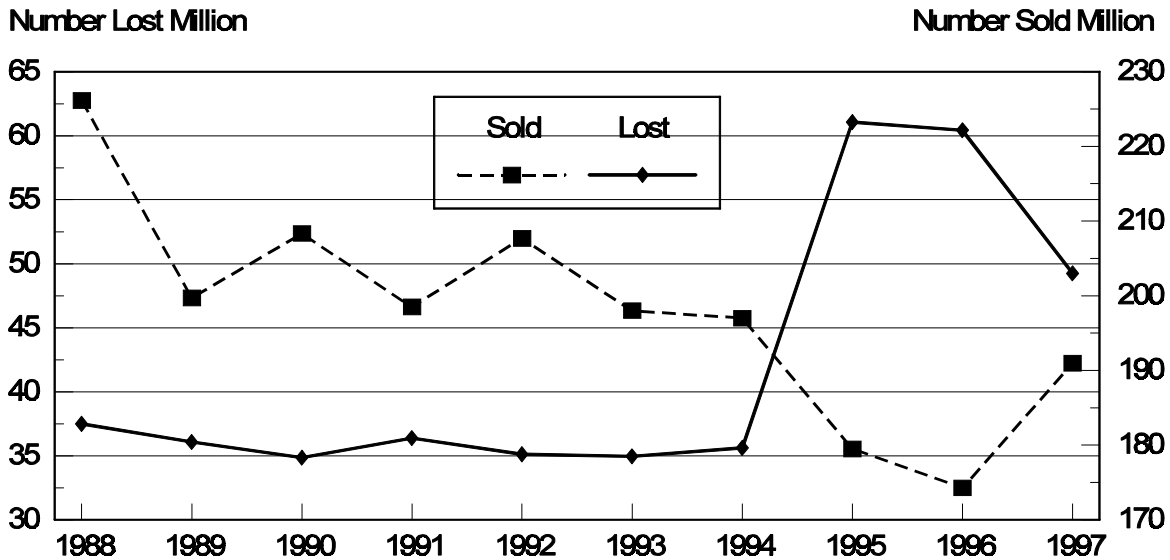
