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Summary

Poultry - Production and Value: Final Estimates by States and United States, 2003-2007, U.S. Department of Agriculture Statistics Board, National Agricultural Statistics Service, Statistics Board, Statistics Bulletin No. 1028.

Procedures: Revisions were made after a thorough review of the original survey data and all data now available, including the 2007 Census of Agriculture. The 2003-2007 estimates shown herein are considered final and will not be revised again.

The Census includes all places from which \$1,000 or more of agricultural products, including government payments, were produced and sold, or normally would have been sold, during the census year. Census publications also include demographic items such as sex of operator, residence on or off the farm, days worked off farm, years present on farm, age group categories, race, and number of persons living in each household.
