




IDAHO Weekly Potato Shipments




COLUMBIA BASIN, WA & UMATILLA BASIN, OR Weekly Potato Shipments




WISCONSIN Weekly Potato Shipments




SAN LUIS VALLEY, COLORADO Weekly Potato Shipments






TOP 5 POTATO SHIPPING AREAS Week Ending December 08, 2018




IDAHO & MALHEUR COUNTY, OR Weekly Onion Shipments




PERU Weekly Onion Shipments




COLUMBIA BASIN, WASHINGTON Weekly Onion Shipments




COLORADO Weekly Onion Shipments
