COLUMBIA BASIN, WASHINGTON Weekly Onion Shipments

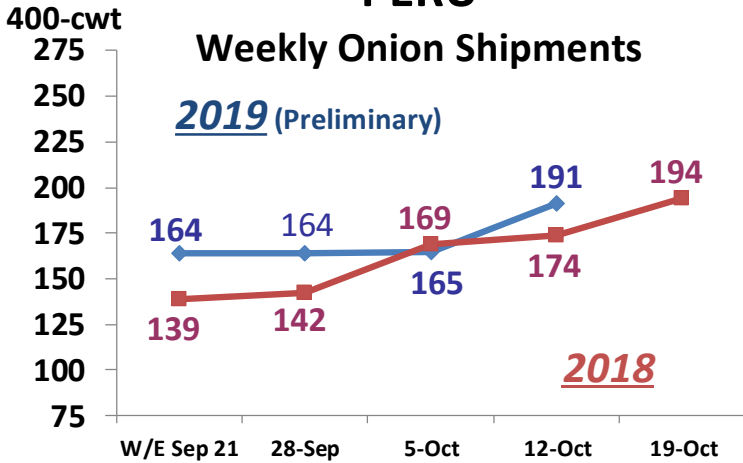


COLORADO Weekly Onion Shipments

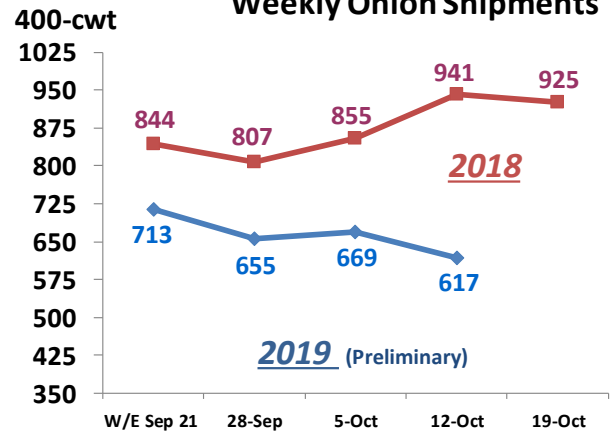

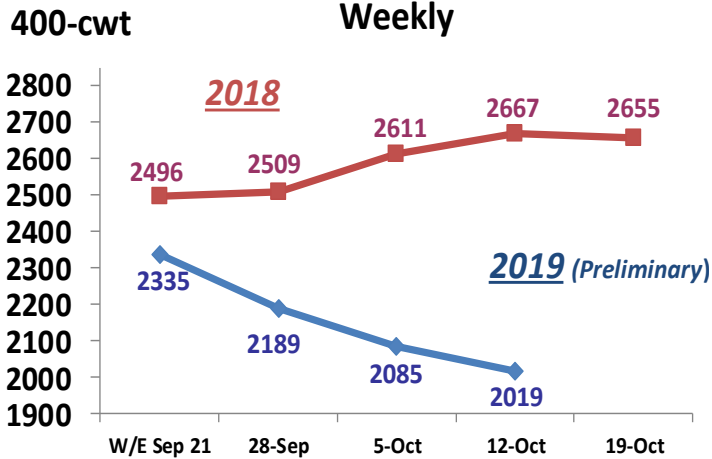

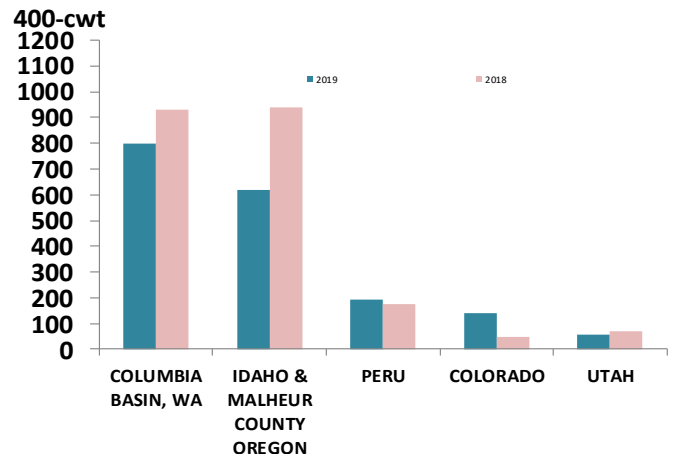
