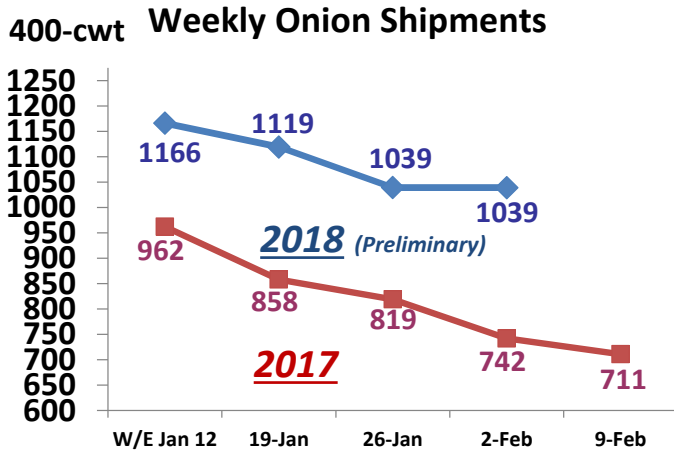
IDAHO & MALHEUR COUNTY, OR Weekly Onion Shipments



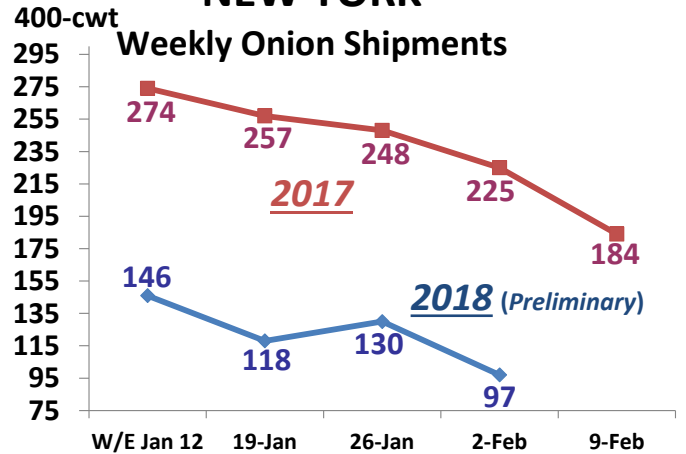
PERU Weekly Onion Shipments



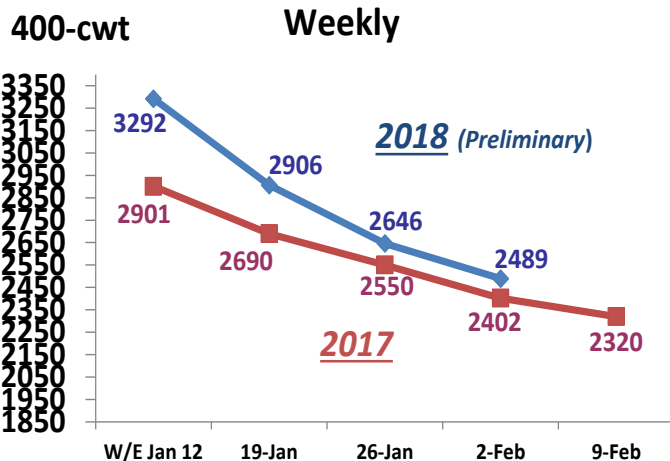
COLUMBIA BASIN, WASHINGTON Weekly Onion Shipments



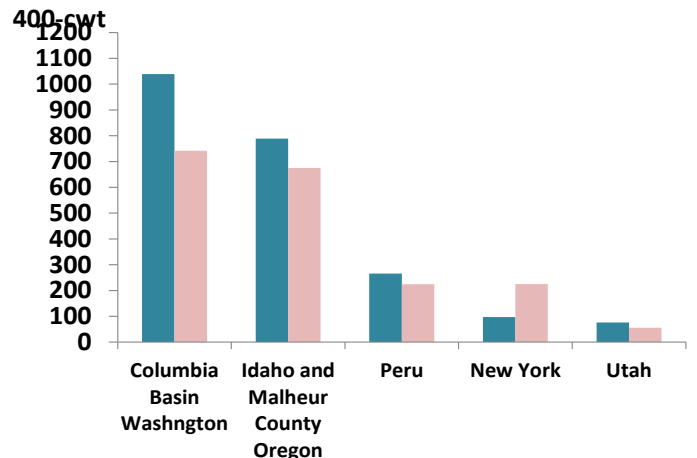
NEW YORK Weekly Onion Shipments
