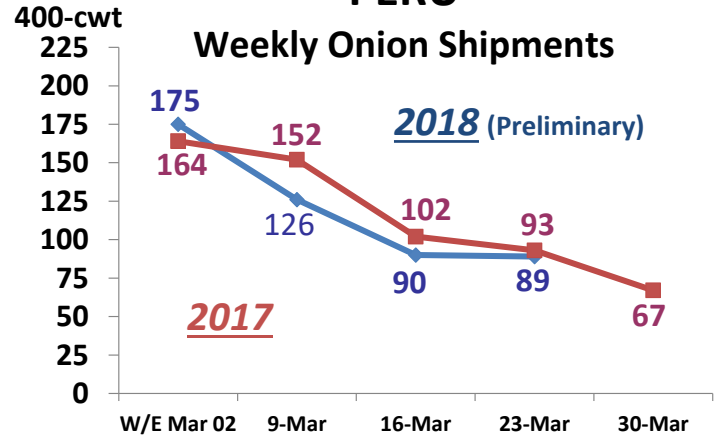
1,000 CWT TOP 5 POTATO SHIPPING AREAS Week Ending March 23, 2019



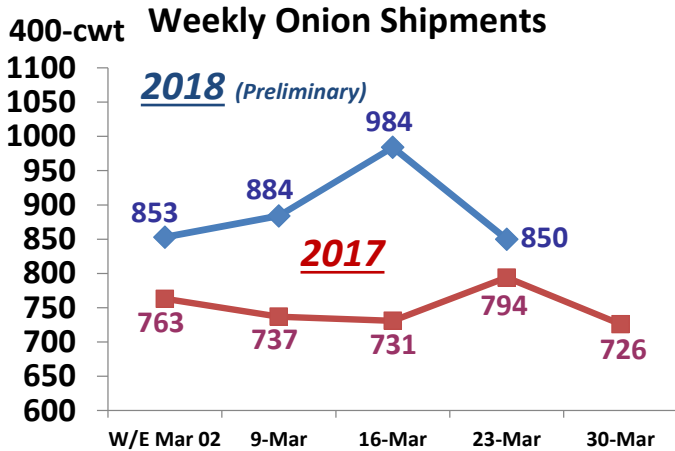
IDAHO & MALHEUR COUNTY, OR Weekly Onion Shipments



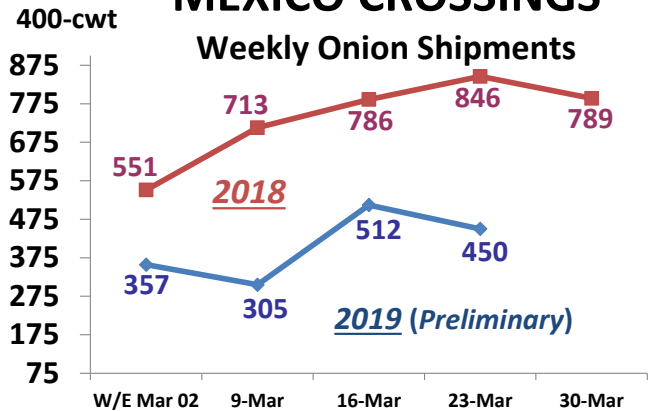
PERU Weekly Onion Shipments



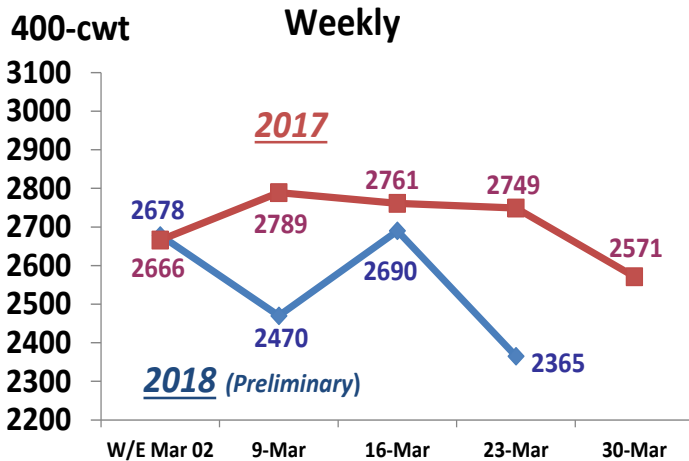
COLUMBIA BASIN, WASHINGTON Weekly Onion Shipments



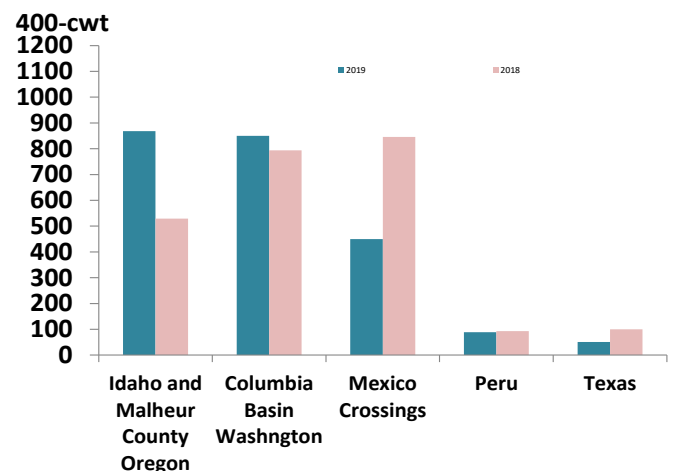
MEXICO CROSSINGS Weekly Onion Shipments

Expected movement is for the period March 24-April 06, 2019. Prices are for Monday, March 25, 2019 compared to Monday, March 18, 2019. Unless otherwise stated, sales are F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis (including Delivered Sales, F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis) or port of entry and extra services are included. Prices represent open (spot) market sales by first handlers on product of generally good quality and condition unless otherwise stated and may include promotional allowances or other incentives. No consideration is given to after-sale adjustments unless otherwise stated. Brokerage fees paid by shipper are included in the price reported.
