

# Chickens and Eggs

Layers, Potential Layers, Rate of Lay and Egg Production  
Monthly 1968-1969

Egg production in 1969 totaled 68,925 million eggs, according to the Crop Reporting Board. The 1969 production is 345 million less than the 1968 production of 69,270 million eggs.

Layer numbers during 1969 averaged 313.3 million, a slight decline from the 315.0 million average of 1968. The annual average production per layer on hand in 1969 was 220 eggs, the same as in 1968.

Potential layers (hens and pullets of laying age plus pullets 3 months old and older not of laying age) on farms January 1, 1970 are estimated at 375 million, up 3 percent from a year earlier. Of the 375 million birds, 87 percent were of laying age and 13 percent were pullets 3 months old or older not of laying age. Pullets under 3 months old are estimated at 50.3 million birds. The laying flock on January 1, 1970 was composed of 57 percent pullets and 43 percent hens.
