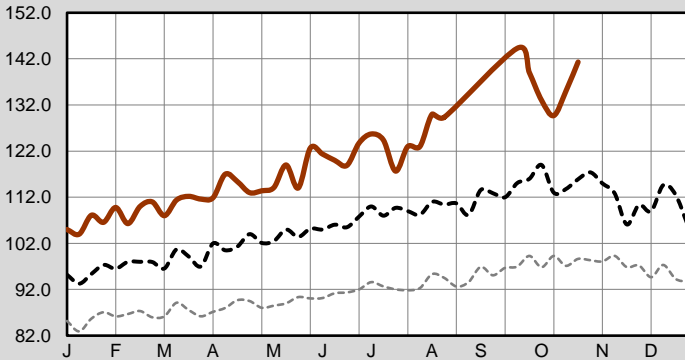

(weighted average price in cents per pound; f.o.b. shipper dock)

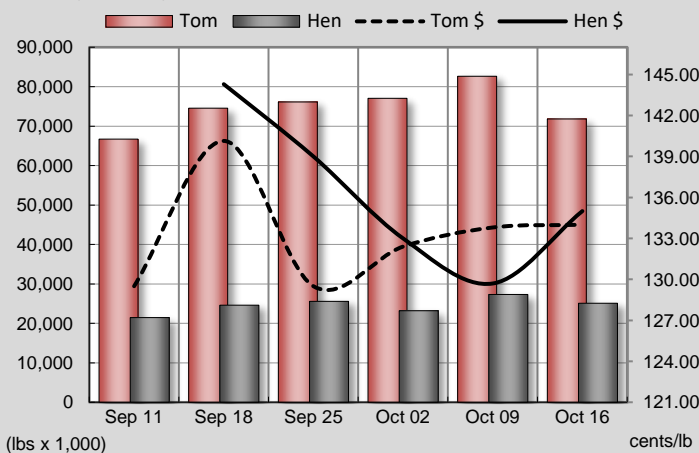


National FRESH Hen Trend

(weighted average price in cents per pound; f.o.b. shipper dock)

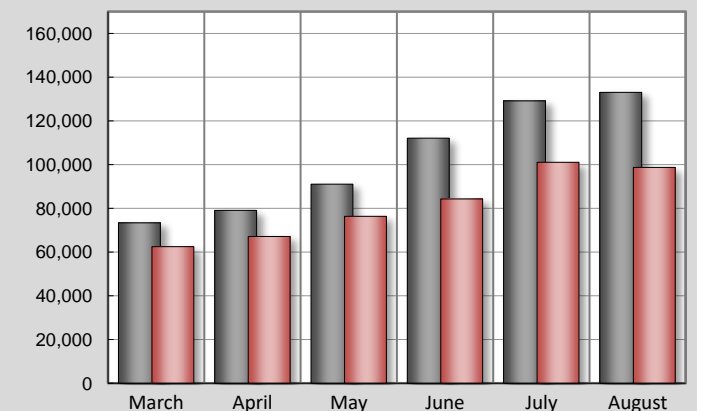


Weekly Turkey: RTC Volume vs. Frozen Price
