## ONION STOCKS UP 4 PERCENT

Stocks of onions in common storage in eleven summer onion producing States and in cold storage in all areas of the U.S. on January 1, 1979 are estimated at 5.91 million cwt., 4 percent above January 1, 1978 and 13 percent above two years ago. Cold storage holdings at 67.0 thousand cwt. are 6 percent larger than a year ago. Seven of the eleven States reported increases in common storage holdings.

Sales from the 1978 onion crop prior to January 1, 1979 were 17.5 million cwt., 6 percent more than in 1977. Losses prior to January 1 from shrinkage, waste, and cullage amounted to 3.52 million cwt., virtually the same as a year ago. Higher losses in California, Colorado, Minnesota, Utah, Washington and Wisconsin were offset by smaller losses in Idaho and eastern Oregon, Michigan, New York, Ohio and western Oregon.

NOTE: Stocks estimated in this report relate to quantities of sound onions held by growers and dealers. Excluded from these stocks are quantities of onions lost before January 1 through decay, sprouting and dumping. It also excludes gradeout to January 1 and any onions on hand January 1 which do not meet grade standards. Sound onion stocks on January 1 include onions which may be lost after that date from decay and sprouting and marketable onions which may be dumped after January 1 because of economic reasons.
