### Direct Hay Weighted Average Report for week ending 7/25/2025

Compared to the last report: Hay prices are mostly steady across all regions with light to moderate demand. Moderate to Heavy supplies were reported in all regions. According to the US Drought Monitor, improvements were made in the Hill Country and Trans-Pecos regions of Texas in response to improving conditions during the past 30-90 days. In these regions, targeted improvements were made in all drought categories (D1-D4). For the week, average temperatures were generally above normal in eastern areas of the region, with anomalies ranging from 2 to 8 degrees F. Conversely, the western extent of the region, including much of Texas and Oklahoma, experienced temperatures ranging from 1 to 5 degrees F below normal. Texas reservoirs are reported to be 80% full, with many in the eastern part of the state in good condition (over 90% full), while numerous others in the western portion of the state continue to experience below-normal levels, according to Water Data for Texas (July 23). The next available hay report will be August 08, 2025.
