Please Note: The above volumes (tonnage, acres, and bales) listed on this USDA LPGMN report are for confirmed trades only, it does not include estimated volume (tonnage) for bids or offers to the trade.

Compared to the last report: Hay prices are firm to 10.00 higher per ton in the Panhandle, West, North, and Central Texas. Hay prices are mostly steady to firm in South and East Texas. Hay supplies continue to tighten across all regions. Producers fed more than expected last week as a winter storm bringing snow and record breaking cold reeked havoc across the state. A lot of hay producers are sold out or near sold out as livestock producers are still stocking up preparing for drought conditions to continue throughout the spring. According to the US Drought Monitor, much of Texas saw degradations with dryness, especially over the last 4 months, dominating the indicators. Coupled with the dryness, the recent cold snap also has impacted winter wheat, with the regional agronomist stating that the drought has probably caused more loss to winter wheat across the region than the recent weather events. Early estimated losses from the recent winter storm are at least \$600 million, with \$230 million in damages to citrus, \$228 million to livestock, and \$150 million to vegetable crops in Texas. South Texas has received some rain this past week, but more is needed to keep them from expanding their drought categories and to keep them on the right side of average precipitation for the area. Heavy rains fell in Northeast Texas, and some notable rain was reported in Far West Texas around El Paso. The rain in the far west improved the drought condition from exceptional to extreme. However, they still have a long way to go to improve range conditions in the area.
