Please Note: The above volumes (tonnage, acres, and bales) listed on this USDA LPGMN report are for confirmed trades only, it does not include estimated volume (tonnage) for bids or offers to the trade.

Compared to the last report: Hay prices remain firm in all regions. Soil moisture levels have shortened, as high winds and warmer temperatures have been the story across the majority of the state. Field prep and planting is taking place, but higher input costs especially in the form of fertilizer has some producers concerned. Additionally, Texas row crop producers might have the luxury of choosing between sorghum, corn and cotton as all three commodities are seeing high prices with the 2021 planting season underway, according to a Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service expert. According to the NOAA Climate prediction center, there is a 60 percent chance that the La Nina pattern will continue along the Great Plains and through the Rocky Mountains. This means below-normal precipitation is most likely for a region from the West coast across the Rockies to the southern Great Plains. The highlighted area of below-normal precipitation is forecast to slowly shift north and east during the summer months while above-normal precipitation is favored to expand southward along the eastern seaboard over the same period.

Due to limited sales and price changes this report will be released bi-weekly until more volumes of hay is moving.
