Some exporters are selling damaged hay at reduced prices in order to make way for new crop. Dryland and range producers are starting to get concern about low moisture levels. Trade very slow this week as most interests are waiting for new crop. Demand remains light to moderate as most interests know there is still a lot of old crop inventory.
