Compared to 2 weeks ago Friday, Utility/Supreme and retail Good quality Alfalfa steady in a light test. Exporters remain on the sidelines. Some exporters telling producers that their export customers are looking for Alfalfa testing 170 or better RFV. Trade remains slow as dairies and retail customers are the only ones interested in buying. Demand remains good for higher testing and retail supplies, light for off grade supplies as the trade area has received very little winter weather so far.
