Compared to last Friday, Utility/Fair Alfalfa steady in a light test. Other grades and export and retail hay not reported this week. Producers remain bullish on new crop supplies as dairy and red meat exports in March 2021 broke records. Some new crop harvesting of hay has occurred in the southern part of the basin but no new sales reported as of yet. Grain prices continue on an uphill spiral. Trade slow with light to moderate demand as most interests wait for new crop supplies.
