## OREGON CRIMSON CLOVER FORECAST 61 PERCENT ABOVE LAST YEAR

Oregon's 1976 production of crimson clover seed is forecast at 3,220,000 pounds, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 61 percent above last year's Oregon production of 2,000,000. Anticipated yield of 460 pounds per acre compares with last year's 400 pounds per acre.

Estimates of acreage, yield and production for crimson clover seed were discontinued in Alabama, Georgia, Mississippi and Tennessee following the 1975 crop because of declining production in these States. Oregon's production comprised 90 percent of the U. S. total in 1975 and 81 percent in 1974.

No farm carryover of old crop crimson clover was reported in Oregon.

Stocks of old crop crimson clover seed held by dealers in the U. S. on June 30, 1976 is estimated at 637,000 pounds, which compares with 145,000 pounds a year ago.
