CITRUS FRUITS

By States, 1966-67 and 1967-68
Production, Use and Value

This report presents statistics on production, farm disposition, price, value, and utilization of sales for the 1966-67 and 1967-68 crops of citrus fruits. The revised production and utilization estimates are based on data available at the end of the marketing season such as marketing agreement records, recorded rail and truck movement, quantities inspected, and quantities used by processors. Allowances are made for unrecorded local sales and quantities used on farms where grown. Estimates for California's 1967-68 crops of Valencia oranges, grapefruit, and lemons are preliminary, as records are not yet complete for the marketing season.

Citrus production for the 1967-68 season was 8.4 million tons, 28 percent less than the 11.5 million tons produced in the 1966-67 season. Orange production was down 31 percent, grapefruit 22 percent, and lemons down 2 percent.

Of the 125 million boxes of oranges produced during the 1967-68 season, approximately 80 percent were grown in Florida, 16 percent in California, and the remaining 4 percent in Texas and Arizona. Florida produced 75 percent of the 1967-68 U. S. grapefruit crop.

Processors used 65 percent of the U. S. citrus fruit produced last year, compared with 67 percent of the 1966-67 crop. About 75 percent of the oranges, 50 percent of the grapefruit and 44 percent of the lemons were used by processors, compared with 75, 55, and 48 percent, respectively, for the 1966-67 season.

Value of production for the 1967-68 citrus crop is 591 million dollars, 18 percent above the value of 1966-67 production. (The value estimates in this report cover the marketing season and should not be confused with cash receipts from these crops for a calendar year.)

Historically, the estimates of production for Temples in Florida have been included with Early and Midseason oranges. Beginning with the 1968-69 crop season, forecasts of production for Florida Temples will not be included with oranges but treated as a separate crop as are tangerines, tangelos, lemons, and limes. Estimates of production, use, and value for Florida oranges for the 1966-67 and 1967-68 crop seasons included in this publication do not include Temples. Tables 7 and 8 show an historical series of estimates for Florida "All Oranges" and United States "All Oranges," excluding Temples.
