CELERY: In New York, the celery crop is in good condition. Growth has been slightly slower than normal. Michigan's celery harvest is in full swing. Quality is good with no major insect or disease problems. Favorable market prices are pushing harvest of younger celery.

Harvest is complete in Florida.

Celery transplanting, direct seeding and harvesting in the Central Coast of California continued active. Growing conditions have been favorable.
