ANNUAL NAVAL STORES REPORT

April 1, 1975 - March 31, 1976

TURPENTINE PRODUCTION HITS 20 YEAR LOW

Domestic turpentine production during the 1975-76 crop year totaled 447,590 fifty-gallon barrels. This is 8 percent less than the 1974-75 crop year output and the lowest in the last two decades. The total was comprised of 5 percent gum turpentine, 9 percent steam distilled, and 86 percent sulphate turpentine.

Compared with the previous years' production, sulphate output was 6 percent lower and steam distilled was off 34 percent. Gum turpentine production was 33 percent higher.

AVAILABLE SUPPLY OF TURPENTINE SHRINKS

The available supply of turpentine during the 1975-76 crop year totaled 576,970 barrels compared with 617,520 barrels available during the previous crop year.

Turpentine imports were larger than the previous year, amounting to 58,640 barrels. This figure may be subject to revision later. Stocks of turpentine at all locations except retail on March 31, 1975 were 30 percent less than 1974. Gum turpentine stocks were 51 percent lower, steam distilled 45 percent lower, and sulphate turpentine 21 percent less.

TURPENTINE CONSUMPTION DROPS

Consumption of turpentine was reported 20 percent lower during the 1975-76 crop year than a year earlier. Industrial consumption was reported at 353,870 barrels compared with 439,730 barrels during 1974-75. The season average price for gum turpentine was \$1.59 per gallon, \$.20 higher than a year ago.

ROSIN PRODUCTION DOWN 16 PERCENT

Rosin production during the 1975-76 crop year amounted to 1.10 million drums compared with 1.31 million drums the previous year. Production this year consisted of 60 percent tall oil, 33 percent steam distilled, and 7 percent gum rosin. Compared with the previous year production was down 6 percent for tall oil and 35 percent for steam distilled but was up 32 percent for gum rosin.

AVAILABLE SUPPLY OF ROSIN 12 PERCENT LESS

Supply of rosin during the 1975 crop year was 1.39 million drums, 12 percent less than the previous year.

Stocks on hand March 31, 1975 at all positions except retail totaled 282,750 drums compared with 107,950 drums on the same date in 1974.

Imports amounted to 20,930 drums, a dramatic 87 percent drop from the previous year.

ROSIN CONSUMPTION DROPS

The reported industrial consumption of rosin dropped 12 percent during the 1975-76 crop year compared with the previous year. Of this total the chemical and rubber industries consumed 379,450 drums, the paper industry 309,510 drums, and the makers of ester gums and synthetic resins 211,970 drums.
