TURKEYS TESTED

The number of heavy breed turkeys tested by official State agencies for pullorum disease during June 1967 were reported at 102,648, up 143 percent from the same month a year earlier. The number of heavy white turkeys tested increased 79 percent. Other heavy breeds tested during the month totaled 34,424 compared with 4,122 in June 1966. Testings of heavy breeds during June were at a seasonal low period of the year. Aggregate testing of heavy breed turkeys from July 1966 through June 1967 totaled 3,970,943, an increase of 6 percent from the comparable period a year earlier.

Light breed turkeys tested during June totaled 12,673 compared with 43,790, a decrease of 71 percent. Testings of light breeds for the period July 1966 through June 1967 totaled 381,165, about the same as a year earlier.

CHICKENS TESTED

Chickens tested for supplying hatching eggs for broiler-type chicks during June 1967 totaled 2,110,394, up 22 percent from June 1966. Accumulative testings for July 1966 through June 1967 totaled 30,500,639, an increase of 16 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Testings of chickens during June for supplying eggs for hatching egg-type chicks totaled 338,765, an increase of 15 percent from June 1966. Egg-type birds tested July 1966 through June 1967 totaled 7,977,923, up 6 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Testings summarized in this report are tabulations of records from Official State Testing Agencies. The degree of coverage may vary from month to month and from State to State. This report is prepared in cooperation with the National Poultry Improvement Plan, the National Turkey Improvement Plan, Official State Agencies, the Animal Husbandry Research Division of the Agricultural Research Service and the Agricultural Estimates Division of the Statistical Reporting Service.

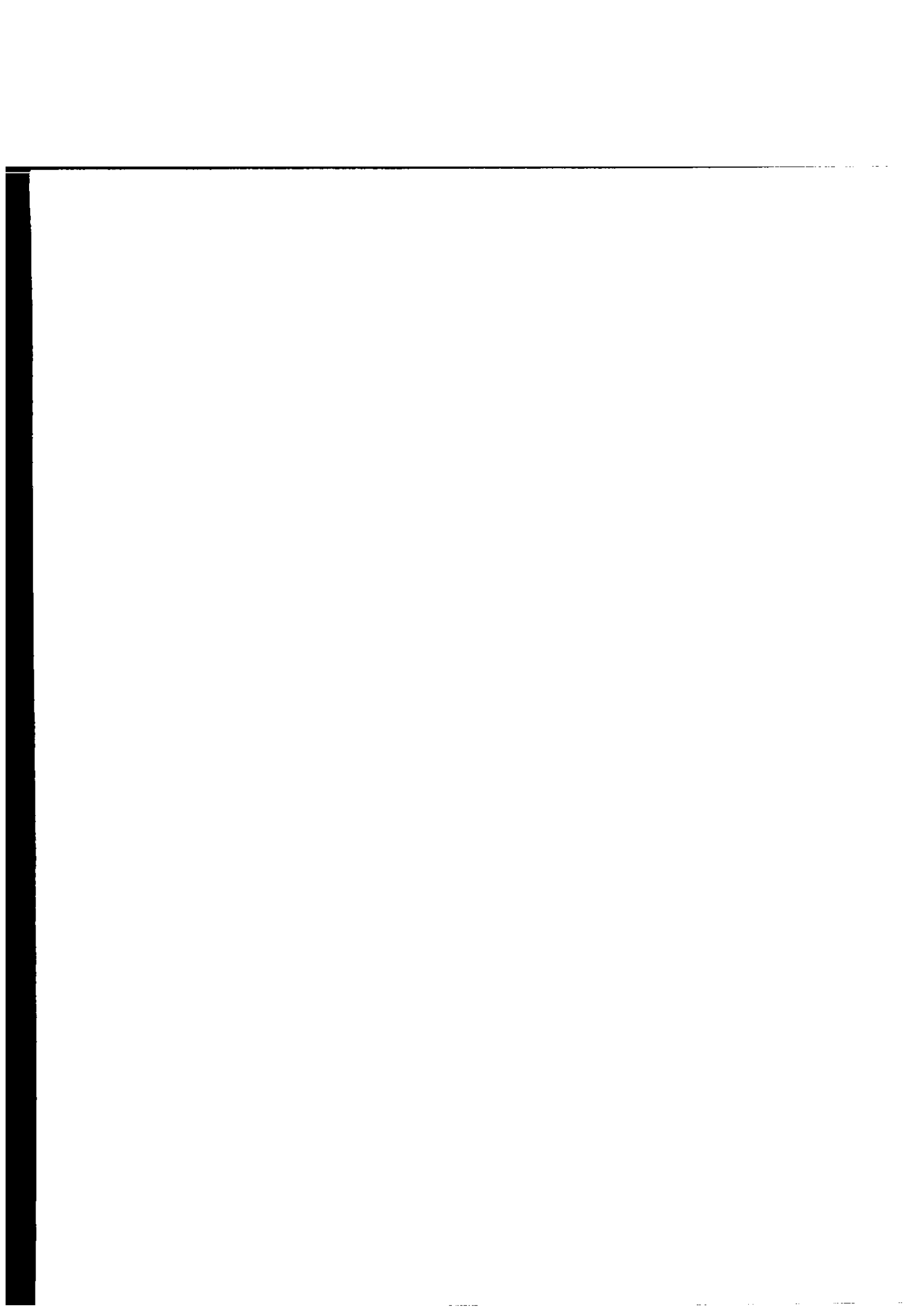
