Turkeys Tested

The number of heavy breed turkeys tested during July, the first month of the 1962-63 testing year, was less than the number tested in July 1961. Heavy white breed turkeys tested totaled 67,767, compared with 72,391 in July last year--a decrease of 6 percent. Testings of other heavy breeds (mostly broad breasted bronze) totaled 9,899, compared with 57,257 in July 1961--a decrease of 83 percent.

The number of light breed turkeys tested during July 1962 totaled 9,842, down 47 percent from July 1961.

Chickens Tested

There were 1,595,617 chickens for supplying broiler hatching eggs tested during July--down 2 percent from July 1961. The number tested for supplying eggs for egg-type chickens totaled 409,851, up 26 percent from July 1961.
