Milk output is steady to lighter in the Central region. Contacts in the southern portion of the region say high temperatures continue to have a negative impact on milk production. In the Midwest, stakeholders say mild weather has kept production steady from last week. Spot loads of Class III milk are becoming more difficult to find in most of the region, but some cheesemakers say downtime at nearby production facilities is keeping some spot volumes available at below Class prices. Cheese production is steady in the region. Contacts report light retail and food service cheese demand but say sales of curds are steady. Export demand for cheese is strong.
