NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are 8 cents lower for Jumbo, 6 to 8 cents lower for Extra Large, 8 to 8.5 cents lower for Large, 7 to 8 cents lower for Medium, and 7 cents lower for Small. Prices in New York are 2 cents lower. The undertone is steady to lower. Supplies vary by location, ranging light to instances heavy. Offerings are moderate to at times heavy. Retail demand is in a range of light to good. Food service demand is light to moderate. Market activity continues slow to moderate. Breaking stock offerings are light to occasionally heavy for the moderate demand. Spent hen offerings are moderate to heavy for normal processing schedules.

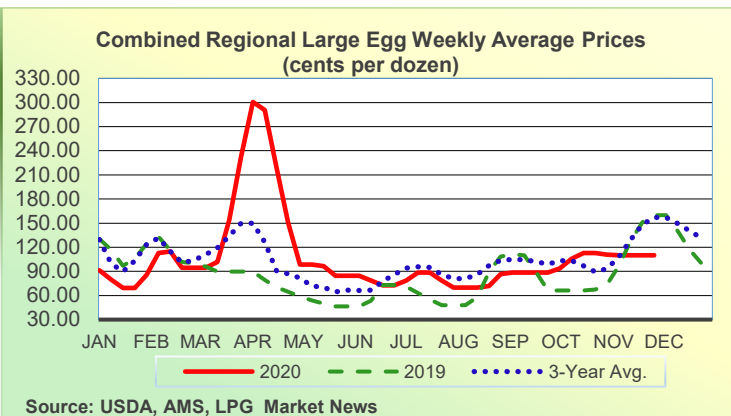

Prices are trending steady. Demand is seasonally moderate for the moderate to heavy offerings of spent hens. Processing schedules for next week returns to normal following the Thanksgiving holiday. Market activity is slow to moderate. The majority price for removal costs are unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Feature activity is moderate to good with best interest being in the Midwest and Southeast regions.
