## NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California egg prices are unchanged to 2 cents lower for Extra Large, unchanged to 7 cents lower for Large, and unchanged for Jumbo, Medium and Small. Prices in New York are steady. The undertone is mostly steady. Supplies are light to available, usually moderate. Offerings are moderate to instances fully adequate. Retail demand is light to fairly good, generally moderate. Food service demand is light to moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock offerings are moderate for a light to moderate demand. Light hen offerings are moderate to heavy for normal to less than normal processing schedules.

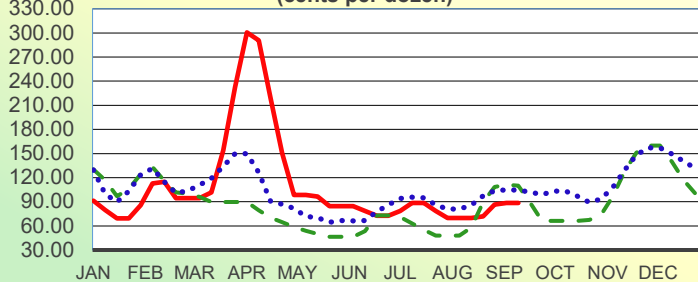

Processing schedules for next week returns to normal to less than normal following the holiday. Market activity is slow. The majority price for removal costs are unchanged at 0-7 cents per head.
