



EGG MARKET NEWS REPORT

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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are down 9 cents for Jumbo, 5 to 11 cents lower for Extra Large, down 5 to 10 cents for Large and steady for Medium and Small. New York egg prices are unchanged on all sizes. The undertone is at best steady to barely steady, while firm on Medium in California. Offerings are moderate to at times heavy. Retail demand is light to moderate with distributive demand moderate to at times fairly good in some areas. Supplies are moderate to instances ample for needs to start the last week of the month. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock floor stocks are moderate to fully sufficient; breaking schedules are mostly full-time. Light type fowl offerings are moderate for the light demand.

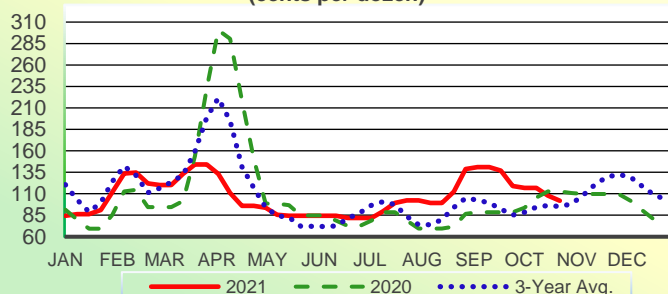
