



EGG MARKET NEWS REPORT

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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are 7 cents lower for Jumbo, down 14.5 to 20 cents for Extra Large and Large, 3 to 9 cents lower for Medium and Small. New York prices are unchanged on heavier weight eggs and Medium. The undertone is steady to instances barely steady. Offerings are generally moderate. Retail and food service demand is in a range of light to fairly good. Supplies are moderate to at times heavy for trading purposes to start the week. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock floor stocks are light to moderate, breaking schedules are reduced to moderate. Spent fowl demand is light on sufficient offerings.

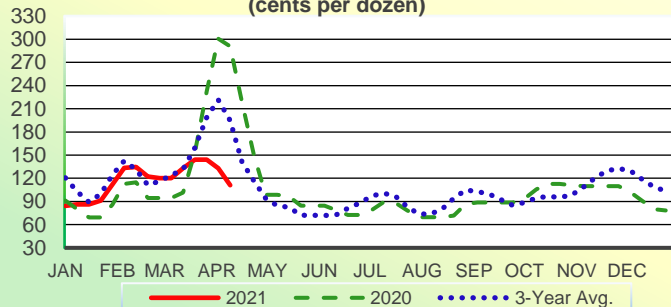

Liquid Eggs

All liquid egg product prices continue too few participants to report prices. Trade sentiment is steady to barely steady for whole egg, steady for whites and steady to fully steady for yolk. Offerings are moderate for whole egg, usually moderate for yolk and light for whites. Spot demand is moderate for whole egg and whites and fairly good for yolk. Contractual agreements are the main focus for most liquid egg movement while food service movement is reported as continuing to improve. Market activity is moderate.
