NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California egg prices are 3 cents higher for Jumbo, unchanged to 3 cents higher for Extra Large, and unchanged for the balance of sizes. New York egg prices are steady. The undertone is steady to instances firm. Supplies range light to heavy, generally moderate. Offerings are usually moderate. Retail demand is mixed, usually light to moderate. Food service demand is light to moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock offerings are light to moderate for a light to moderate demand. Light hen offerings are moderate for normal to less than normal processing schedules.

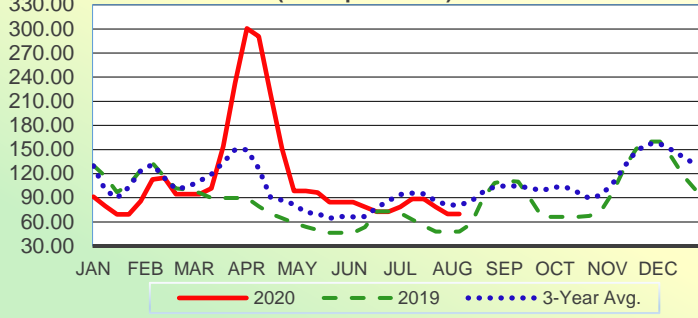

Frozen whole egg prices are steady to lower with frozen whites and sugared yolk prices steady and salted yolk steady to higher. The undertone is steady for all frozen egg products. Offerings range light to moderate on all frozen egg products with most held in confident hands. Supplies are light to moderate. Demand is in a full range of light to fairly good for whole egg and whites and moderate to fairly good for frozen yolk products. Market activity is slow to moderate.
