NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are unchanged, however 9 cents lower for Extra Large and Large in California. New York prices are steady on all sizes. The undertone is steady to barely steady. Retail demand is light to mostly moderate. Distributive demand ranges light to at times good. Offerings are light to usually moderate, while adequate to fully adequate in California. Supplies to start the week vary, ranging light to instances heavy for current needs. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock offerings are moderate to available for the moderate to fairly good demand. Light type hen offerings are moderate to heavy; processing schedules are normal to less than normal.

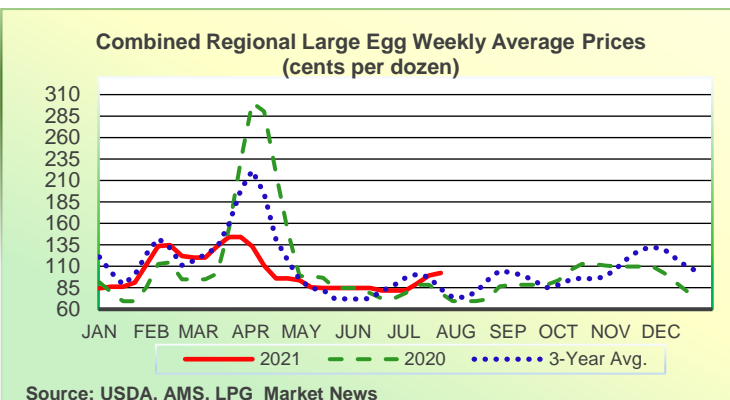

Liquid Eggs

Certified liquid white prices are lower with the balance of liquid egg products prices too few trades to report prices. Trade sentiment is steady for whole egg and yolk and steady to barely steady for whites. Offerings are light to instances moderate on all liquid egg products. Demand is light to moderate while contractual movement continues to move liquid product through normal channels. Market activity is slow to moderate.

Frozen egg prices are steady for salted yolk and steady to lower for whole, whites and sugared yolk. The undertone is mostly steady to lower. Offerings are light to moderate. Demand is moderate to fairly good with whole egg and frozen yolk products in the stronger position. Trading is generally based on contractual and seasonal needs. Supplies are at times light to moderate for current needs. Market activity is moderate.
