



EGG MARKET NEWS REPORT

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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are unchanged for Jumbo, 5.5 to 10 cents lower for Extra Large, down 7.5 to 10 cents for Large, steady to 6 cents lower for Medium and Small. Prices of New York eggs are unchanged on larger sizes and Medium. The undertone is steady to weak. Offerings are mostly moderate to available. Demand into the retail and food service channels range light to fairly good, mostly light to moderate. Supplies are moderate to instances heavy for needs to start the week. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock offerings are adequate to available for the moderate to at times fairly good demand. Light type fowl offerings are at least adequate; processing schedules are normal to less than normal.

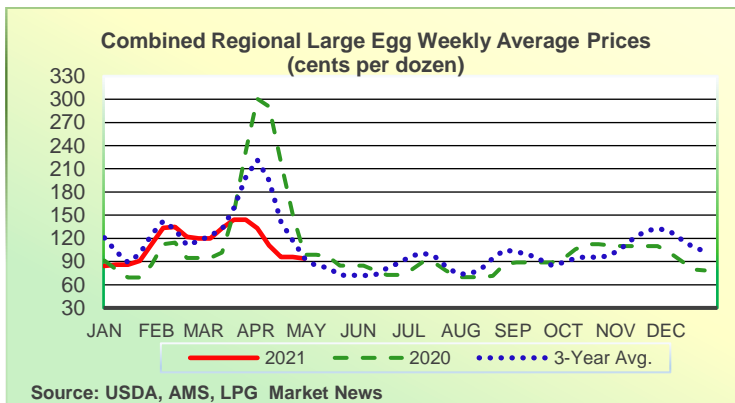

Liquid yolk prices are steady to higher with certified white prices lower and the balance of liquid egg product prices too few trades to report prices. Trade sentiment is mixed for whole egg, mostly lower for whites and steady for yolk. Offerings are light to moderate. Demand is light to moderate for whole egg and whites and fairly good for yolk. Offerings are light to mostly moderate. Market activity is moderate to active.

Demand is moderate to instances fairly good while food service related business continue to show improvement. Offerings and supplies are light to moderate. Market activity is moderate.
