



EGG MARKET NEWS REPORT

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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

California and regional prices are 2 cents lower for Jumbo, 2 to 8 cents lower for Extra Large, 0.5 to 6 cents lower for Large, 0.5 to 2 cents lower for Medium, and 1 cent lower for Small. New York prices are unchanged for all sizes. The undertone is generally steady. Transportation has returned to normal following last week's storm and store shelves are being replenished. Offerings continue light to moderate. Supplies are light to fully adequate. Retail demand is moderate to good, while distributive demand is very light to moderate. Market activity in California moderate to active, elsewhere is slow to moderate. Breaking stock supplies are light to adequate for normal breaking schedules. Spent hen offerings are more than sufficient for the light demand.

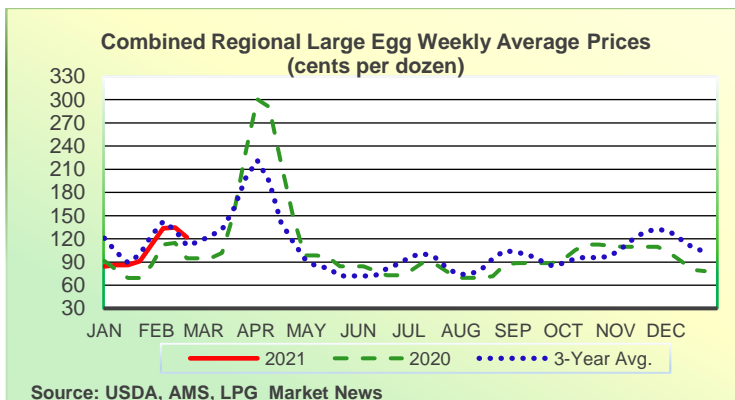
