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NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California egg prices are unchanged for Jumbo and Small, unchanged to 2 cents higher for Extra Large, Large, and Medium. Prices in New York are steady. The undertone is steady to about steady. Offerings are light to at times available. Supplies are light to fully adequate. Retail demand ranges light to fairly good, mostly moderate to fairly good. Food service demand is mixed, generally moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock offerings are light to moderate for a light to fairly good demand. Light hen offerings are at least moderate for normal to less than normal processing schedules.

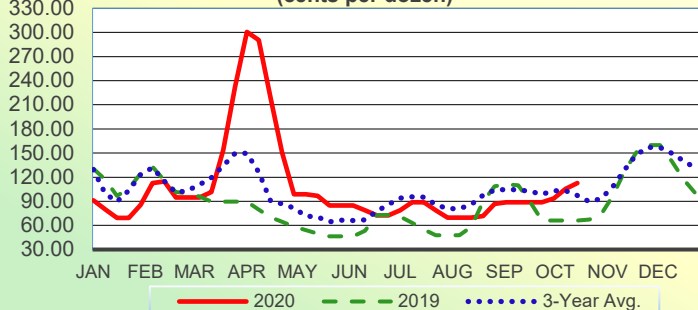

Processing schedules for next week are normal to less than normal. Market activity is slow. The majority price for removal costs are unchanged at 0-7 cents per head.
