



# EGG MARKET NEWS REPORT

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## NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are down 2 cents for Jumbo, 8 to 9 cents lower for Extra Large, down 8 to 11 cents for Large, while 2 to 4 cents higher for Medium and up 2 cents for Small. Prices of New York eggs are unchanged on all sizes. The undertone is steady to lower. Offerings are moderate to instances fully adequate. Retail demand is light to moderate and food service demand moderate to fairly good. Supplies are in a full range, mostly moderate to fully adequate for trade needs. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock floor stocks are sufficient; breaking schedules are full-time. Spent hen demand is light and unaggressive on moderate offerings.

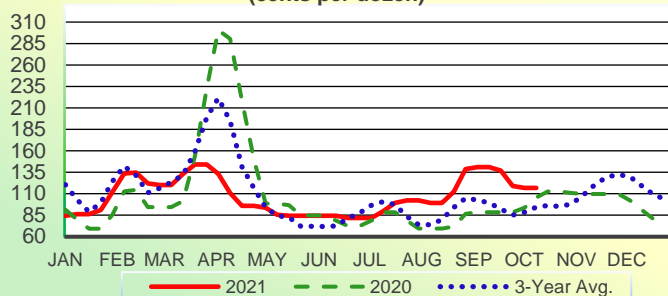
