NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are up 3 cents for Jumbo, 2 to 7 cents higher for Extra Large, up 3 to 9 cents for Large, 2 to 3 cents higher for Medium and Small. New York prices to begin the week are unchanged on all sizes. The undertone is about steady to steady. Offerings are light to moderate in the regions, while available in California. Demand into the retail and food service channels in a full range, generally moderate to fairly good. Supplies to start the week vary by location and are mostly moderate to instances heavy for trading purposes. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock floor stocks are moderate; breaking schedules are full-time. Spent fowl offerings are at least sufficient for the light demand.

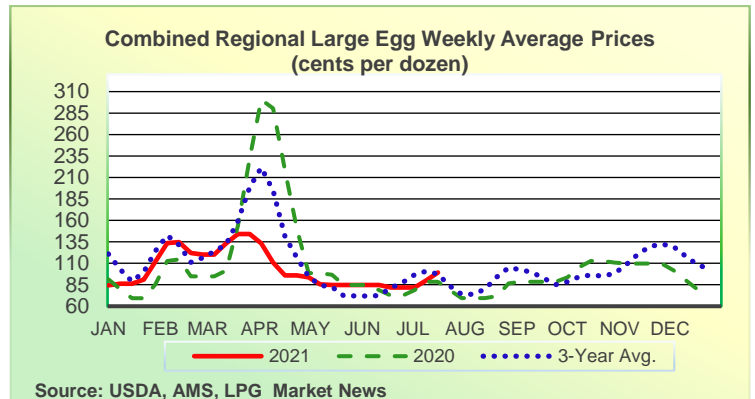
