NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are 5 cents lower on Jumbo, down 2 to 6 cents on Extra Large, 0.5 to 9.5 cents lower on Large, steady to 6 cents higher on Medium, unchanged on Small. Prices of New York eggs are steady on all sizes. The undertone is steady to about steady. Offerings are moderate to at times available. Retail and food service demand varies and in a range of light to fairly good, mostly moderate. Supplies are mixed, generally moderate to fully adequate for needs to start the week. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock floor stocks are sufficient; breaking schedules are irregular. Light type hen offerings are at least moderate for the light to moderate demand.

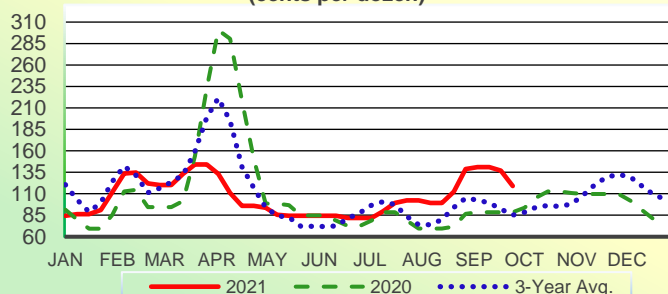
